Club Policies & Rules

1. Clubbers may not be dropped off prior to 5:50 pm. Clubbers must be supervised at Family Café.
2. The Game Circle and game equipment are off limits until 5:50 pm.
3. For the safety of the clubbers: No clubber is to leave the church grounds for any reason. If there is an emergency, please inform the Director or Commander before you leave.
4. Clubbers must not leave the building at the end of club night without their adult ride home. No playing in the playground until your parent has picked you up. Parents only may pick up younger clubbers.
5. All clubbers must take part in the entire program unless he/she brings note from a parent.
6. No running in the building or parking lot except during designated games. No playing or running on the stairs or handrails.
7. Clubbers must be respectful to the workers, other clubbers and property at all times.
8. Handbooks may only be signed off for awards by Leaders after the child has recited verses to the Leaders. Clubbers may say verses to a Leader on Sunday if they wish. No awards unless a Leader signs off handbooks.

Discipline:

To make the evening more enjoyable for everyone, we use a 5-count for regaining order and 3-count for individual discipline. The 3-count is used by the Club Director. If your child reaches a 3-count, we will notify you of the problem.

Winter Weather:
